NOTIFICATION

The Additional Skill Acquisition Programme Kerala (ASAPK), a Section 8 company under Higher Education Department, invites application from qualified and competent candidates for appointment to the post of '**Executive Engineer**' on contract basis for a period of one year or till any Government orders. Interested candidates may apply via **ONLINE** mode only by filling the prescribed application form given in the website of ASAP (www.asapkerala.gov.in) or Centre for Management Development (CMD), Thiruvananthapuram (<https://cmd.kerala.gov.in>). The online application submission link will open on **10.10.2023 (10.00 am)**. The last date for submitting the online application will be **23.10.2023 (5.00 pm)**.

Note: Candidates will have to upload their passport size photograph (taken within six months), signature and Certificates proving qualification and experience while submitting the application. The photograph and signature must be in JPEG format. The size of the photograph must be less than 200 kb and the size of the signature should be less than 50 kb.

DETAILS OF POST

ASAP reserves the right to shortlist only a limited number of candidates for test/group discussion/interview, as the case may be for the post, based on marks secured in their qualifying examination and experience. Candidate should clearly mention the marks scored in

their qualifying examination in the application. The conversion of grade/CGPA to percentage would be based on the procedure certified by the University from where they have obtained the degree. The onus of proving the conversion from grade/CGPA to percentage of marks would rest with the candidate.
